GTA Dashboard Terms

Version: 23 July 2026

PREAMBLE

These GTA Dashboard Terms ("Dashboard Terms") supplement the GTA Licensed Data – General Terms ("General Terms") for the GTA Dashboard delivery channel only. They apply where an Order includes the Dashboard. They do not incorporate the GTA API Terms, which apply only where the same Subscriber separately receives direct API access. Capitalised terms not defined herein have the meaning given in the General Terms.

The General Terms govern all matters relating to the Licensed Data itself, including intellectual property, licence classes, usage restrictions, warranties, liability, and governing law. These Dashboard Terms address only the operational terms specific to the Dashboard channel. A Dashboard subscription confers access to the Licensed Data through the Dashboard only; it grants no right of access through, and no right arising under the terms applicable to, any other delivery channel.

1. ADDITIONAL DEFINITIONS

- **'Dashboard'** means the hosted, web-based application provided by SGEPT that presents Licensed Data through interactive visualisations, filters, and analytical tools.
- **'Dashboard Applications'** means the analytical modules made available within the Dashboard.
- **'Dashboard User'** means an individual within the Subscriber's Organisation who is authorised to access the Dashboard under the Order.
- **'Notification Services'** means automated alerts delivered via email, messaging platforms, or other channels integrated with the Dashboard, to the extent specified in the Order.

2. SCOPE OF ACCESS

2.1 Order-Defined Configuration. The Licensor grants the Subscriber a non-exclusive, non-transferable right to access and use, during the subscription term, the Dashboard Applications, datasets, exports, functions, and Notification Services identified in the Order. No entitlement to any other Dashboard Application, or to the current or future portfolio of Dashboard Applications, is granted by implication. The Order may distinguish a standard dashboard configuration from bespoke or custom work; no development, configuration, or future modules are included unless the Order says so. SGEPT may add, modify, or retire Dashboard Applications from time to time, provided that material changes to the Subscriber's configuration are communicated with at least thirty (30) calendar days' notice in accordance with General Terms Section 17.

2.2 Notification Services. Where the Order includes Notification Services, the Subscriber may configure alerts for policy changes relevant to its interests through the channels specified in the Order. SGEPT shall use commercially reasonable efforts to deliver notifications promptly, but does not guarantee real-time delivery. Notifications are informational alerts and do not constitute advice or a recommendation to act; General Terms Section 2.3 applies to all Notification Services.

3. ACCESS MODEL AND USER MANAGEMENT

3.1 Access Metric. Dashboard access is licensed on a concurrent-session basis. The Order must state both the eligible organisational population entitled to hold Dashboard User accounts and the maximum number of simultaneous active sessions. Session limits are a throttle on simultaneous use; the licensed population is defined by the organisational scope declared in the Order (General Terms Section 1, Authorised Users), not by the session limit.

3.2 Authentication and Access Control. Each Dashboard User must authenticate individually. The Subscriber is responsible for ensuring that Dashboard User accounts are not shared between individuals; promptly deactivating accounts of individuals who are no longer authorised; implementing multi-factor authentication where made available by SGEPT; and maintaining the security of all user credentials within its organisation.

3.3 Session Management. Dashboard sessions time out after thirty (30) minutes of inactivity. SGEPT may terminate sessions that exceed the session limit stated in the Order.

4. EXPORTS, SCREENSHOTS, AND EXTERNAL USE

The Subscriber's permitted use of Dashboard outputs (including data extracts in CSV or Excel, visualisations, charts, reports, and screenshots) is determined by the licence class selected in its Order under the General Terms, together with Permitted Citation. An output does not become freely shareable because the Dashboard generated it: external sharing beyond Permitted Citation requires Derived Use (for Materially Transformed Output) or Redistribution (for Recognisable GTA Content), each as granted under General Terms Section 4.5, and all exported material remains subject to the General Terms, including Sections 4.6 and 5.

5. VISUAL PRESENTATION AND ACCEPTABLE USE

The Dashboard presents the Licensed Data through interactive visualisations, colour-coded indicators, scenario tools, and other analytical interfaces designed to facilitate the Subscriber's analysis. The Subscriber acknowledges that the visual presentation of data may create an impression of precision, completeness, or definitiveness that exceeds the inherent accuracy and completeness of the underlying data. The data source limitations in General Terms Section 2.4 apply regardless of how the data is presented. The interactive tools apply analytical models to the Licensed Data and are subject to the same limitations; SGEPT makes no warranty that the Dashboard will identify every policy measure relevant to the Subscriber's business. In addition to the restrictions in the General Terms, the Subscriber shall not use automated tools to access, scrape, or extract data from the Dashboard interface; reverse-engineer any part of the Dashboard; circumvent access controls or session limits; frame or embed the Dashboard interface in third-party applications without SGEPT's prior written consent; or present Dashboard outputs to third parties as constituting professional advice.

6. RELATIONSHIP TO THE DATA SUBSCRIPTION; TERMINATION

The Dashboard is a delivery channel within the Subscriber's Subscription; it does not itself grant a data licence separate from the Licensed Data scope selected in the Order. Termination or expiry of the Subscription ends Dashboard access. Where the Order bundles the Dashboard with other delivery channels under a single term and fee, the Dashboard cannot be terminated separately unless the Order

states the fee and access consequences of doing so. Rights to access the Licensed Data through other delivery channels after Dashboard access ends continue only where and to the extent the Order expressly grants them.

7. SERVICE LEVELS

A GTA Dashboard Service Level Agreement applies only where, and as, expressly incorporated in the Subscriber's Order. These Dashboard Terms do not themselves promise uptime, support windows, or service credits. Where no Service Level Agreement is incorporated, the Dashboard is provided in accordance with the General Terms without separate service-level commitments.

8. INCORPORATION

The General Terms govern all legal terms applicable to the Subscriber's use of the Dashboard, including without limitation intellectual property (Section 3), licence and restrictions (Section 4), attribution (Section 5), nature of service and no reliance (Section 2), data security (Section 7), warranties and disclaimers (Sections 11–12), limitation of liability (Section 13), indemnification (Section 14), term, suspension, and termination (Section 16), modification (Section 17), precedence (Section 18), and governing law (Section 21), in each case of the General Terms.
